LOGLINE

Younes feels lonely and by recording nostalgic memories, intends a great Departing!

SYNOPSIS

Younes is listening to his childhood voice on the road with his old walkman ... A mother and a little boy walking there ... He arrives In front of a boutique hotel and sits at a certain point. In the hotel at night, Younes records his inevitable decision on Departing! there is a photograph of Younes, right like where he sat at the beginning of his arrival at the hotel ... Behind the photo is a note of his lost lover (Mitra) while his recorded voice of Walkman talking to his deceased mother ... night goes to the morning and he is still lying there ... On the same primary road, we approach the mother and child walking and the little boy returns ... The picture of mother and child is a photograph!

OUR STORY

In the midst of countless economic problems in Iran,
I consciously decided to bring my next short
film, which I had been contemplating writing for
months, to the production stage... Some of the best in
Iranian cinema also helped me and worked hard for
eighteen to twenty hours a day (Due to the limited
production days), just because of devotion to the art!

To take the final scene around 3 at midnight, the leading actor had shoulder dislocation when he had to throw himself on the bathroom floor, and our veteran DoP had very swollen legs due to the high working hours and diabetes... But instead after making sure the shoot is complete, I went straight to the hotel lobby in order to prepare my schedules for tomorrow morning. That night I felt myself more like an executioner than a director!

I was born in the eighties and my initial Theater & Film writings started around when I was admitted to the University of Art with great interest in theater at the age of 20... In that four-year period, I wrote several short and long plays including a short screenplay about the life of a painter in only one crypt, which was inspired by my cousin's life. I also wrote poetries and I was full of love... After graduation I was experiencing analogue photography as well as writing other excerpts and a complete manuscript of my first feature film over the years, I gradually made a short film in 2019. Named "Cold Ashes" which was accepted in some film festivals. A year of dramaturgy and a lot of financial and production difficulties. At the beginning of 2022, after five months of post production, I made my next short film, called "Departing" with a lot of hope and looking forward...


Makeup Designer, Reza Arabi

1- what's the theme of your film?

loneliness and isolation are main themes in this film. A fundamental concern of the modern man that is more or less felt all over the world... War, loss of a loved one, or the death of a family member and sometimes selfishness could be an important cause of loneliness and isolation... It's a super theme.

2-Why did you consider the hotel as the essential location for the act?

The hotel is like a miniature of the whole world, different people from everywhere, with the potential for different events and sometimes with a common pain.

3- why did you make the film in Black & White? it evokes passion, a unique kind of nostalgic mood which is naturally emotional. it takes you through the time. And it turns the attention inward. These were all true to the nature of my film.

4- why does this film, look old school and modern at the same time? from the get go it was my fixation to be as much Loyal to a vintage modern style of look as possible, in order to capture a timeless combination of my narrative. And I did it the same in every single part of production and post.
